

HISTORY OF YUKOYAR-SRIJEM COUNTY

The 8000 years rich history in this area makes it impossible to select the most... the most valuable, the most interesting, the most special... Some parts of our historical mosaic and heritage have crossed the borders of our fields with their importance and have become a part of European and world heritage.

The archaeological locality Vučedol, which is situated on the banks of the Danube River near Vukovar, is a place of continuous settlements and one of the most important archaeological localities in the country. Due to the importance of its findings it gave the name to a whole Eneolithic culture, and at the same time it is its origin. Vučedol was a settlement that inhabited peasants, farmers, hunters and copper processors, which had its "golden era" from 3000 to 2200 BC. The Vučedol dove was found there in 1938.

The oldest inhabited settlement with the longest continuity of living is Vinkovci. Series of archaeological findings, among them the most interesting Orion —the oldest European calendar, prove that. The pot found in the center of the town Vinkovci, on site of today's hotel "Slavonija", with a range of painted symbols is the oldest record of time measurement in Europe — 8000 years old. From that time until today, man has never left this area.





Customs

The area of modern-day Vinkovci has been inhabited for more than eight thousand years. Many people and civilizations exchanged here, leaving their traces behind which the archeologists uncover and in which the citizens of Vinkovci can take pride. Some of the people who passed through these lands, either through migrations or wars, influenced the life and the customs of the indigenous inhabitants - the Šokci.

Nowadays, however, the Šokci way of life is passing, and we can learn more about it by reading the books of the local writers and from the lovers of these lands, as well as by visiting the Museum or by having a talk with some newly-married woman who still lives such a life. In order to prevent the customs from being completely forgotten, many individuals, associations and institutions organize various workshops, gatherings, seminars, fairs and, of course, festivals.

To this end, many associations based in the City area work to keep alive the customs of Šokadija, which are: needleworks (embroidery, golden embroidery, šlinganje, toledo, and the like), weaving, pottery, bottle staining, gourd painting, making national garments, as well as the preservation of the authentic dance and song, customs such as picking feathers, distilling rakija and many more). 
Rustic houses


